South Central Transit (SCT) announced today that the organization experienced record-breaking ridership during the month of September by providing 40,367 trips throughout its district. This represents a significant ridership increase in comparison to one year ago when the average trips per month was 36,000.

The public demand is changing and SCT is implementing changes to meet the demand by adding shuttles from city to city and county to county. SCT riders are finding the shuttles convenient for travelling to and from work, school and medical appointments, and are also recognizing significant savings in fuel costs and personal vehicle operations.
