

Title VI Notice to the Public

South Central Transit (SCT) gives public notice of its policy to assure full compliance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 and all related statutes. Title VI requires that no person in the United States of America shall, on the grounds of race, color, sex, or national origin, be excluded from the participation in, be denied the benefits of, or be otherwise subjected to discrimination under any program or activity for which SCT receives Federal financial assistance.

Any person who believes they have been discriminated against under Title VI has the right to file a formal complaint within 180 days of the alleged discrimination. Individuals and organizations may file a complaint with the Federal Transit Administration's Office of Civil Rights by obtaining the complaint form from www.fta.gov/documents/TitleVIComplaintform.doc.
